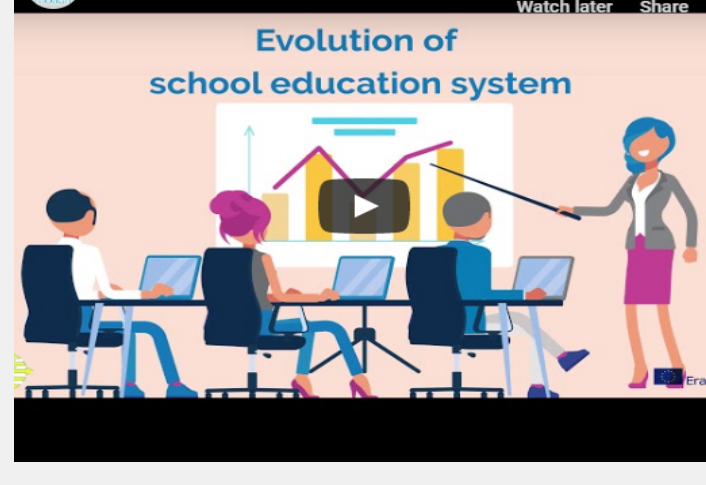

## Focus Groups

Eight focus groups have been organized with the participation of experts all around Europe. The aim was to validate the L-CLOUD competence model. The focus group gathered experts with different profiles, including innovation teachers, ICT coordinators, managers and principals of educational institutions and educational decision makers. We collected in-depth information about their perceptions of Leadership competences on Cloud Education, and revised the competence model created by the project, and their different components: knowledge, skills and dispositions (provisions or attitudes). Some of the competences were reformulated, and few ones were added.

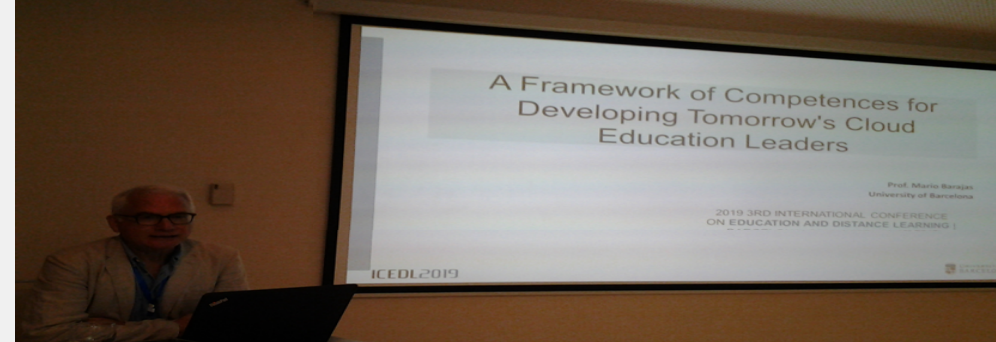

## Conferences

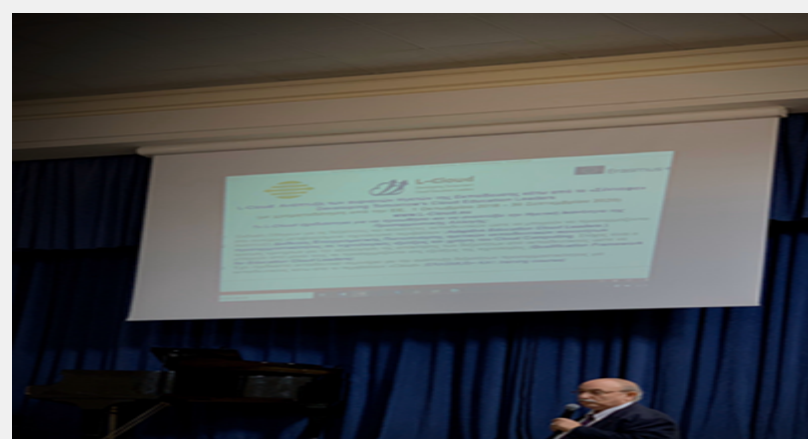
